Dear Parishioners:

The summer months seem to be flying by. In just a few short weeks we will be seeing the ads for back to school clothing and supplies. This time also signals the beginning of our PSR sign up process.

PSR stands for the Parish School of Religion. This program is mainly for students who do not attend the Catholic school yet are in need of continuing education, not only for the sacraments, but for their ongoing development of faith. This is a very important responsibility that parents have. Registration forms have been sent out to families as of this writing. If you are new to our parishes or have not received a letter they are available in the back of our churches or by contacting either parish office.

Our PSR staff works very hard to prepare and present lessons for our children of all ages. Remember that all of our staff members are volunteers. They give of their time and talents because they are committed to their faith and want to help parents share their faith with their children. Make no mistake about it this is a very important ministry they are a part of. Your participation as parents is most important as well. We try and put forth to our children a faith filled program. Therefore your cooperation is most important.

The PSR staff goes out of its way to keep all of you informed about the program and your responsibilities as parents. Your participation is vital to the faith development of your children. If you have any questions or concerns we will do our best to answer them for you.

A few years ago we changed the PSR program from Wednesday evenings to Sunday mornings. We did this to avoid the conflicts we were having with evening school activities. I feel this change has been successful for us. Attendance is better and more families are attending mass as a family unit. I think you can see this when you come to the 10:30am mass during the PSR season. Our churches are full. This is one of the successes that have been achieved by this change. We still have a conflict or two at times yet we have seen an increase in attendance and parental participation.

I would ask your prayers for our PSR staff and students as we prepare for this upcoming year. God bless.
