Dear Parishioners:

I would like to inform you that beginning the 20<sup>th</sup> of this month and ending on June 24, 2010 the priests of the Diocese of Toledo will be at our convocation at Sawmill Creek in Sandusky. That means that there will be no masses at either parish that week. There will be communion services at both parishes at the regularly scheduled mass times. This happens for our diocese every other year. This format of priests gathering started in the late 1970's. Our meetings began at Sienna Heights College in Adrian, Michigan. We met there twice. We then moved to Maumee Bay State Park and now we hold our gatherings at Sawmill Creek.

I guess the main question people would ask is, "what happens during these days?" First and foremost we gather for prayer and fellowship. Then there are sessions given by visiting priests on different topics. Then there is free time for us as well. Most of the priests of the diocese attend along with our bishop. Even most of the retired priests attend. I would ask that you pray for all of us during that week.

The following week Vacation Bible School will be held at St. Anthony Parish. This program is open to all of the Milan area churches. During this week, due to the bible school program, there will be no masses at St. Anthony's. The bible school program uses the church at the beginning of the day for their prayer services. I would ask that you pray for all the students and staff that will be attending the Vacation Bible School in Milan.

I want to say a few words about the upcoming RCIA program that will be beginning in the month of September. Last year 3 members from St. Anthony's Parish and one member from St. Mary's participated in the program and joined our parish communities. We are looking for anyone who might be interested in participating in this upcoming program this year. If you know of anyone who might be interested in exploring our Catholic faith please let me know. You can contact me or Linda Salmons and we will do our best to contact those individuals and meet with them to explain what RCIA is all about. At this time we have four individuals who have committed to being part of RCIA this year. RCIA stands for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. This process is for anyone who is considering becoming a part of the Catholic faith. If you know of anyone who may be interested please ask them. Sometimes that is all it takes. Your involvement at this stage of their journey is very critical to their spiritual journey. If you know of anyone who maybe interested in joining our faith please ask them and let us know. 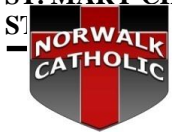
