Dear Parishioners:

Let me begin with a reminder. In just a few weeks our weekend mass schedule will be changing. The weekend for the change will be July 3-4. Please keep this in mind. We will do our best to remind you of this change.

On July 3, 2010, the first Saturday of the change, our mass will be held at Edison Park in Milan. This year it will be held in the upper pavilion. In the past this mass has been very well attended. In addition to the mass we will be holding a picnic. You will be asked to bring a dish to share and place settings for you and your family. I know this is a holiday weekend but this is a great way to start by attending mass and celebrating with your fellow parishioners. In the past we have had very good attendance. I hope to see many of you there.

I have many parishioners ask me if I am extending my term at our parishes. The term for a pastor is for six years with the possibility of six more. The extension is up to the bishop, pastor and the needs of the diocese. As of this writing I am planning to stay. Unless things change I plan to stay put. Unfortunately, we just lost Father Keith McCormick, an active priest of the diocese. Father Keith was sick for quite a few years and finally his problems caught up with him. In this past year we have lost two active priests: Father John Brennen and now Father Keith. This adds to the struggles of keeping all of our parishes with a pastor. This task keeps getting more difficult. I would ask you to pray for the repose of the souls of these two priests and also keep all of our priests in your prayers.

We are seeing the administration of parishes and schools change very quickly in this new century. We have witnessed the twinning of our two parishes and the combining of St. Mary's School and St. Paul's Schools into Norwalk Catholic School. This kind of twinning and merging will be continuing as situations change.

I feel that our twinning has been successful due to the cooperation we have had with all of our parishioners. I have heard stories of other twinning situations that have not gone well at all. I feel I have been blessed with both willing parishioners and staff. God has certainly blessed us.

I have read articles of other parishes in other dioceses who have resisted either closing or merging which has caused a great deal of unrest within the parish itself and the diocese. Thank you for your support and cooperation.

I am sure we will be seeing more changes in our diocese as situations present themselves. For our purposes we continue to pray for our success and the success of the diocese. God bless.
