Dear Parishioners:

I want to begin by thanking all of you for your gifts and kind wishes on the occasion of my 35th anniversary of priesthood. Those years have gone by very quickly. Recently, I attended a mass for the “Year for Priests” at St. Joseph’s Parish in Tiffin, Ohio. I had been an associate there from 1978 through 1983. Former pastors and associates were invited to attend. I was amazed at how many of the parishioners remembered me and how many I remembered. That assignment was 27 years ago.

As you are well aware we do need more priests to serve in our diocese. This weekend we will have one young man ordained to the priesthood. Deacon Matthew R. Rader will be ordained by Bishop Blair this Saturday at 11:00am at Our Lady, Queen of the Most Holy Rosary Cathedral. Deacon Rader is from St. Charles Borromeo Parish in Lima, Ohio. It is very good that we have this one vocation but that certainly it not enough. We need to continue to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

Next year we will have three young men ordained to the priesthood. Recently, our parishes celebrated the sacrament of Confirmation at Rosary Cathedral. Bishop Blair was the celebrant for this mass. There were about eight other priests who were in attendance for this mass. As I looked at the priest there, in years of ordination I was the oldest. What a scary thought. That was an eye opening experience. The bottom line is that we do need more vocations. In the last couple of weeks we have seen that more parishes in the diocese have been twinned. This need is due to retirements and unfortunate illnesses that have hit our local clergy. Please continue to pray for vocations.

Another ministry of the church that needs prayers and attention is that of the Permanent Diaconate. Since Deacon Jack has moved to Seattle we do not have the services of a deacon. The order of deacon is very vital to the church of the 21st century. If there are any gentlemen in either parish that might be interested in the Permanent Diaconate please let me know. I would be more than happy to explore this ministry with you. Also pray for all the permanent deacons of our diocese. They do a great deal of valuable ministry for our diocese. God bless.
